

Recommendations for adding water treatment to your website

If you're going to offer water treatment to your clients I highly recommend you put the information on your web site. The content provided should be used as a guideline for information that will be helpful to your customers.

I recommend you add a primary navigation link for "water treatment" (just like plumbing, hvac, about us, etc). The link should go to a page talking about the need for water treatment (see water treatment document). From there you want a drop down that has a page dedicated to water filters (see water filter content) and a page dedicated to water conditioners (see water conditioner content). This will help to eliminate the confusion between what a filter does versus what a softener or anti-scale system does.

To get the most bang for your buck I also recommend you include your area in the content for best SEO pick up. So instead of saying "water treatment specialist" say "(your town)'s water treatment specialist".
